The Giggly-Wiggly Worm Tree and the Funny Tree

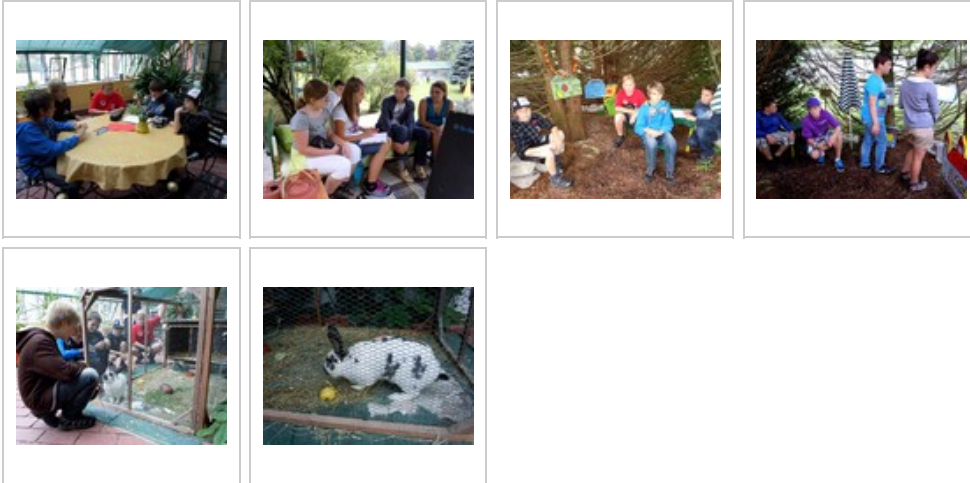


We looked at the book of Mr. Busy and had to find out why he was so busy. Then we were allowed to eat a "worm".

The Greenhouse, Guineapig Town and Hoppi the rabbit

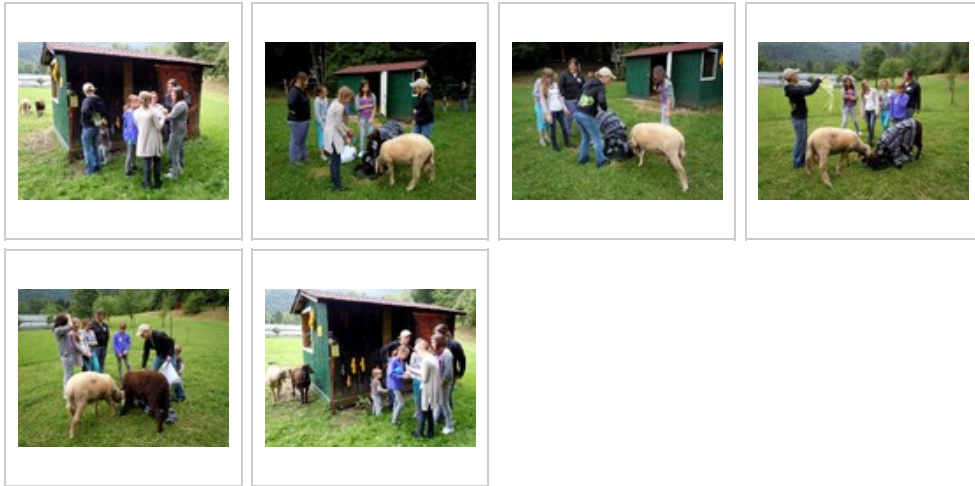


We were allowed to eat a marzipane rose, then we had to write a rhyme.
